IACS Annual Meeting! Be There!

Ten years ago, IACS made getting "independent accreditation" its top priority. After seven years, the legislature passed independent accreditation into law as part of the 2013 education reform bill with a "sunset" provision ending the program in 2020 barring further action.

This year, after ten years of advocacy and on the last day of the legislative session, the legislature passed a budget bill with language that included striking the sunset provision from Code. Independent accreditation will now be there for our students for the foreseeable future.

The six independent accreditation agencies recognized by the Department align with each other, provide a higher bar for our schools, and understand the unique nature of our schools.

Legislators from both parties in both chambers have worked on this for the last 10 years. We appreciate each of them. A special thanks to Senator Schultz, former Rep. Carmine Boal, & Rep. Dolecheck for initially getting the ball rolling on this and a big thank you to Majority Leader Hagenow for working with Reps. Heartsill, Fry, and others to get this done this year. This was a major victory for our students, but we have much work to do moving forward!

There are a number of other issues we worked on or watched this session. Here are just a couple:

Financial Literacy - IACS, the Community Bankers of Iowa, interested legislators, and the Department of Education worked together to create a Financial Literacy Task Force, now the Financial Literacy Network.

This network has hosted a summit, brought in financial literacy experts to work on the issue of financial literacy education, and get resources out to schools.

The initial goals were to measure what is currently happening in the field and make sure educators were able to access quality resources to help plan financial literacy offerings.

IACS is proud to have helped start this network and you can learn more about its current efforts on the Department's website.
